(Decision: CDP No-15 of 2021)

Regarding

Violation of the FUFA COVID-19 Regulations

Note relating to terms of the decision:

The Judicial Bodies have decided to communicate only the terms of the decision. Any request for the grounds or the entire decision must be sent in writing to the FUFA Secretariat within seven (7) days of receipt of the decision. Such a request does not affect the terms of the decision, which come into force with immediate effect.

Circumstances of the case

Disciplinary proceedings were opened against, the management of KCCA FC following the allowing of Fans/Spectators into the stadium for the KCCA Fc Vs POLICE FC match that was played on Saturday 13th March 2021 at MTN-Omondi Stadium Lugogo without a written authorization from FUFA and most of the fans were seen not wearing face masks.

The Competitions Disciplinary Panel considered KCC FC'S defence and made the following findings;

Legal framework

Article 10 of the FUFA COVID-19 Regulations establishes that,

1. *"All matches shall be played without spectators.*
2. *Spectators shall only be allowed with written permission from FUFA.*
3. *Any club/team that violates Art 10(2) above shall be liable to disciplinary action.*

Article 11 of the FUFA COVID-19 Regulations establishes that

'Wearing face masks at all times is mandatory while in the stadium'

Decision

In the present case the Competitions Disciplinary Panel identified and took into account the fact that;

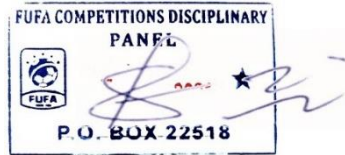
- i. The majority of the fans that were allowed into the stadium were not wearing masks contrary to Article 11(1) of the FUFA COVID-19 Regulations which provides; *"Wearing facemasks covering the nose and mouth at all times is mandatory while in the stadium."*
- ii. KCCA FC has previously been cautioned against violation the FUFA COVID-19 Regulations.

DECISION

Accordingly, CDP hereby;

1. **SANCTIONS** KCCA FC for violation the FUFA COVID-19 regulations with one match under closed stadium for the next home game under the Uganda premier league in the second round.

2. Should you fail to heed to the sanction above, the CDP shall be constrained to take stringent disciplinary measures against you.
